Security

A security fee of £100 is payable per term.

Payment of fees

All fees must be paid by cheque or bank transfer. We accept nursery vouchers.

Upon acceptance of a place for your child, the first term's fees become payable in advance. Subsequent fees are payable on or before the first day of each term. There is no refund in the event of a child's absence from the Gan due to illness, your chosen holidays, and unforeseen closures. You will not be charged for days when the Gan is closed in relation to staff training days or Chagim.

To secure your child's place, when offered, a deposit £100 will be requested. This will be refunded in your child's last half term of attendance in the Gan on the following conditions:

1. We are given half a term's notice in writing before withdrawing your child.
2. Payments of fees are up to date.
3. Should you choose not to start your child; the deposit will only be refunded providing a term's notice in writing has been given.

Early Years 3 & 4 year old funding

Funding goes towards the cost of providing an outstanding EYFS curriculum and expert teaching of your child. It does not cover the cost of consumables, security, lunch, and extra hours/sessions or extra-curricular activities.

We will provide you with the funding declaration form at the beginning of each term. Parents must reapply for their 30-hour funding eligibility code every 3 months. If codes are not renewed or you become ineligible, fees must be paid.

Late collection fees

We expect all parents to arrive punctually when collecting their children, to avoid them becoming anxious and distressed. If you are late, we reserve the right to charge for the additional time worked by our staff, at a rate of £3 per five minutes.

Removal of children

A minimum of half a term's notice in writing must be given before removing a child or reducing hours/days, without exception, or a half term's fees paid in lieu thereof.
