Don't forget our Mum & Tots group on a Thursday morning. It is a lovely group where children and parents can get to know each other before starting at the Ganim.

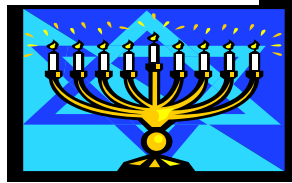

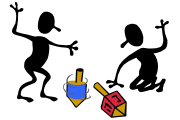
Dear Parents,
