Dear Parents,

This week we looked at 'Animals that live in the cold'. The children made white chocolate rice crispies representing snow and they were all very patient whilst watch the chocolate being melted! Suitable footwear for Gan

If your child comes into Gan in boots or wellingtons please have a pair of shoes/trainers to change them into for the morning. In our experience we have found boots very restricting especially when climbing the larger apparatus.

Please do not send your child into Gan if they have a bad cough or cold as will not benefit from being at Gan if they are under the weather and will only pass on germs. If your child is on antibiotics, please make sure you keep them at home for the first 48 hours of taking the medicine (Sick Child Policy).



- Please ensure you close the gate for your child's safety.
- Please re read our Nappy Changing Policy regarding our 'no unnecessary change' & Pull Ups policy.
- Please to sign the green link book and bring it in every day. Please ensure it is covered in clear plastic.
- Please make sure your child has warm outdoor wear and that **ALL** coats, hats and glove are **CLEARLY** named.
- Please make sure all boys have a **CLEARLY NAMED** kippah in the Basket.
- All boys who are dry should be wearing tzitzit to Gan.
